





APPENDIX A How to build your profile in Whova






APPENDIX B How to Record Presentation Video

- (1) Open your presentation file using Microsoft Power point:
- (2) Go to Slide Show tab and click on Record slide show:



(3) Leave the setting as default and click on Start Recording:




- (4) Start speaking or add markings to your presentation.
- (5) There are different ways to manage recordings in your presentation:
 - a. Pause to pause a recording.
 - b. Close to end a recording.
 - c. Laser Pointer, Pen, Highlighter, or Eraser to use the pointer, ink, eraser, or highlighter tools in your recording.
- (6) Save recording
 - a. when you are done recording save your file as mp4 or avi.
 - b. from the Save As drop down menu choose mp4 or avi.


